



# FRHS Guidelines for Thespian Points

*10 points for induction - minimum 5 points earned at FRHS*

*30 points to earn a FRHS letter*

*ITS honors - 60 pts Honor ITS, 120 National ITS, 180 International ITS (10 of these points need to be from a Fossil Ridge Main Stage Show)*

## **See below for a guide on point submissions:**

- 1.) Go to [cothespians.com](http://cothespians.com) and click "Student Login" located in the top right corner. This should bring you to a new page where you can log in. If you do not already have an account, you can make one by clicking "Register" on the right of the page.
- 2.) After you login/create an account, your profile will open up and there will be a column on the right titled "Actions" with many tabs below it. Select "Events" and from there you will be taken to the page to track/enter your points.
- 3.) Near the top right corner of the page click the icon that looks like a **piece of paper with a plus sign** on it. From here fill out each individual show/conference you have been to or participated in with the Fossil Ridge Theater Company
- 4.) Once all of your points are imputed click on the PDF Icon at the top right corner. Save the PDF and submit it on the "2026 Thespian Point Submission" on the Drama Club Google Classroom.

### **Some things to note:**

- "Producer" is also known as the director of the show or trip you are entering
- Enter the production title or Conference name and date(s) attended or performed
- Enter the role you played in the cast, crew, or pit. If you participated in a conference (ThesCon/ITF) or watched a show name it "Attendee".
- Lastly choose the position you played (there are two options at the bottom of the list) Ask Assmus for clarification of what roles are "major" vs. "supporting" vs. "chorus"
- You can only log shows participated in at Fossil Ridge

One of them is "Participation in a Theatre Festival or Conference" (use this for IES at ThesCon or ITF)

The other is "Attending an Equity performance" (use this for any show you watched as an audience member - only up to 5 total)

- The genre for shows is usually "Full Length" (unless it is a One Act of course)
- Do NOT log each *Performance*! ONLY each *Production*! (For example, the spring musical is one production, not 3 for each night)

### Individual Point Breakdown

- Programs - Marketing Lead (Social Media and lead for Playbill for shows)
- Programs Crew - Marketing Crew (Helps make the Playbill for shows)

### Directing

- Director - If you direct in Intro to Acting
- Assistant Director - If you direct in Intro to Acting
- Vocal Director
- Video Producer
- Assistant Vocal Director - Musical Section Leads
- Music Director
- Choreographer
- Assistant Choreographer - Dance Captain
- Audience Member at another school's show (up to 5 points for whole high school career)

### Writing

- Original Play (produced)
- Original Radio Script (produced)
- Original TV Script (produced)
- Original Play (unproduced)
- Original Radio Script (unproduced)
- Original TV Script (unproduced)

### Miscellaneous

- Oral Interpretation - Audition/ Tech Interview
- Duet Acting Scene
- Participation in Theatre Conference or Festival - If you do a Thespy at ITF/ThesCon (Enter one per day performed)
- Attending Theatre Festival - If you just attend ITF/ThesCon (Enter one per day attended)
- Assembly Program - Attending Bobby Gs/Jimmy Awards

### Officers

- President - If you serve as the Drama Club or Tech Theatre President
- Vice President - If you serve as the Drama Club or Tech Theatre Vice President
- Secretary - If you serve as the Drama Club Secretary
- Treasurer - We don't have this position at Fossil, do not select
- Clerk - If you serve as the Drama Club Historian
- Website Development/Maintenance - If you serve as the Drama Club Social Media Officer

- Other - If you serve as the Improv Club Officers

**Audience Member**

- Attending an Equity (Professional/tour/Broadway) Performance - (up to 5 points for whole high school career)
